

# MMAC Special Access and Departure During Aerospace America 2003

Aeronautical Center employees will have alternate access and departure routes during Aerospace America 2003.

The North Guard Station Entrance will be CLOSED during Aerospace America 2003. Employees departing or coming to the MMAC after 4:00 p.m. on Friday, October 3, and Saturday and Sunday, October 4 and 5 MUST use the South Guard Station Entrance on MacArthur Blvd.

The Foster Gate will be opened from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Friday, October 3 for employees to EXIT ONLY.


**Special Note:**

Duke Avenue will be closed during the air show as indicated and highlighted on this drawing. MMAC traffic will be authorized to meet organizational requirements and employees of the Technical Support Facility will have access to the TSF north parking area.

**ROUTES TO TAKE:**

Airport Road to Rockwell Ave. to SW 74th Street to MacArthur Blvd. into MMAC.

Interstate 44 to SW 104th Street to MacArthur Blvd. into the MMAC.



**Special Parking and Gate**

MMAC employees and accompanying family members holding air show tickets may use the HQ Building east parking lot. They may enter the air show grounds through the gate between Hangars 8 and 9.

The MMAC will enforce all current security levels during the air show. Anyone entering the center with an MMAC employee will have to be registered as a visitor and will be issued a visitor's badge. MMAC Vehicle Identification Media during Aerospace America 2003 will remain the same and all vehicles entering the MMAC are subject to being visually inspected and searched.
